

Literacy

Using the story Vlad and the Great Fire of London, children recapped the main events in the story and thought about how the story would unfold from Boxton's point of view. Children drew a storyboard of the events of Boxton's day and used this to write a diary entry from Boxton's perspective.

Phonics

L1 – children have listened to poems and rhymes. They have enjoyed the silly shop poem and the story Oi! Frog!

L3 – children learnt the GPCs sh, ng and th (voiced as in with and unvoiced as in moth)

L3 – children revisited the GPCs ai and ee and practised writing tricky words l, no and go.

L6 – children learnt the suffix -ies when making a noun ending in y plural.



Maths

Rec: This week the children took part in different sorting activities, they sorted objects by colour, shape and size.

Y1: Children have been finding one more and one less than a given number using a number spinner. We have also introduced ordinal numbers such as 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th.

Y2: Children have counted on and back within 0-100. Children have also been counting in 10s from different given numbers and finding 10 more and 10 less than numbers within 100.



Topic

In Art, children learnt how to mix their own powder paint colours and experimented with colour mixing. Children used primary colours to mix and make secondary colours. In History, children listened to the events that happened during the Great Fire of London. Children created a timeline using pictures and talked through the events. In PSHE children listened to the story We Listen linking to that Golden Rule. Children added this rule to their poster. In Science, children learnt about what different animals eat and the names of these diets. Children used the vocabulary herbivore, omnivore and carnivore. They then found animals that were hiding around the classroom and filled in a table stating their animal group and type of diet. In RE we continued to learn our poem for the Harvest Festival.
